



RESOLUTION 2023-24

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO A VOTE ON ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF DAVIDSON TO CHANGE THE TERMS OF COMMISSIONERS TO FOUR-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS

WHEREAS, pursuant to North Carolina G.S. §160A-101 and §160A-102, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Davidson adopted Ordinance 2023-07 on August 8, 2023, effective upon approval by referendum vote by the residents of Davidson, amending the Town Charter such that members of the Board of Commissioners shall serve four-year staggered terms and the Mayor shall continue to serve two-year terms.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Davidson that:

1. An election is hereby called for Tuesday, November 7, 2023, for the purpose of determining whether the Town of Davidson shall amend its Charter to change the terms of members of the Board of Commissioners from two-year terms to four-year staggered terms.
2. Pursuant to North Carolina G.S §163-287, the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections and Iredell County Board of Elections are hereby requested to conduct the election herein described and pursuant to North Carolina G.S §160A-105 with the question to appear on the ballot substantially as follows:

Question:

Shall the ordinance amending the Town of Davidson Charter that changes Davidson Board of Commissioners term lengths from two-year terms to four-year staggered terms be approved?


